Staff and Hours of Operation

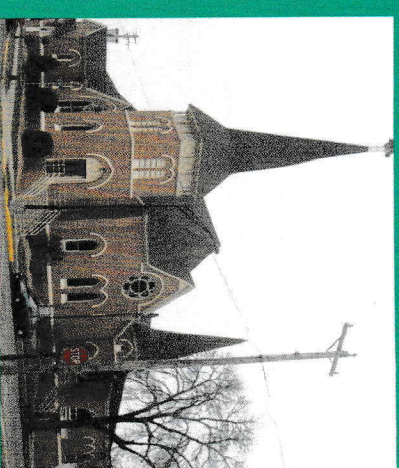

CareLink is an ecumenical mission that provides emergency gas cards to Chippewa Falls residents. (Open During Food Pantry)

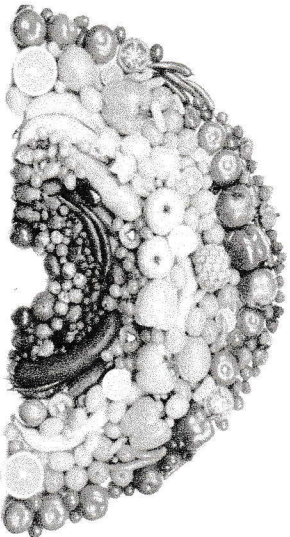

Poverty Myths vs Facts

More than 46 Million Americans live in poverty. Let's debunk some myths about those in need...

Myth: A huge chunk of my tax dollars supports welfare recipients.

Reality: Welfare costs about 1% of the Federal Budget. The majority of those living in poverty do not receive government welfare assistance.

Myth: Those who get on welfare stay on welfare.

Reality: Of those that receive welfare assistance, more than half stop receiving benefits after a year, 70% within two years, and 85% within four years.
